Our Preschool provides quality care in an educationally rich and caring environment for young children of our community aged three to five years. We achieve this through the following areas:

Children:

We are inclusive. We believe in supporting children's positive self-esteem. We believe that each child has unique potential and that they are resourceful and capable. Our educators recognise and celebrate the important learning that takes place during the early childhood years. We encourage children's desire and engagement in play-based learning experiences that develop their interests, well-being, confidence and independence. We promote children's active participation in their own learning. Curriculum decisions are guided by our educators upholding children's agency. We recognise children's different learning styles and utilise a range of pedagogical practices.

We strongly value our diverse family community. We aim to support children's awareness of diversity and promote a culture of acceptance through inclusive practices and celebrations reflecting the diversity of our families and the wider community.

Families and the Community:

We are collaborative. Community is at the core of our values and is what makes the Preschool unique for our families. We build genuine partnerships with parents and families and value their contribution to their children's learning. Our connections with children and families go beyond the preschool years as does our support. Our legacy within the community spans several generations and we celebrate what makes our Preschool unique to achieve such long-term partnerships in the community.
